NEW YORK — GM's GM Motors Corp. will temporarily close its assembly plant across North America, including its truck assembly plant in Wayne, Ind., due to sweeping cuts in production that will dramatically reduce demand.

GM said it will cut vehicles from its production schedule for the fourth quarter of 2009, which will result in 60,000 vehicles less per week. Normal production would be around 75,000 vehicles per week for the quarter. GM spokesman Tom Sapienza said the company is
